PAOD TUITION AND PLACEMENT POLICY

Tuition - PAOD is a tuition based program. families make 10 equal monthly tuition payments. Tuition is collected from September through June.

At registration, one month's tuition is collected and applied to **June 2024** tuition. Once class begins, September through May tuition will be collected. Payments are due monthly by the 5th.

Payment Methods - Cash or Check made payable to Palmyra academy of Dance. Payments can be placed in mailbox #1 at the studio entrance. Credit card and ACH payments are accepted online in your Parent Portal. There is a 3.75% service charge for credit transactions and a 3.0% service charge for ACH transactions.

Tuition Policies - Tuition is based on the number of classes taken. Paid monthly tuition is non-refundable. We do not refund money for missed classes. Registration is non-refundable. June 2024 tuition is refundable. Please be sure to notify the studio by email to drop a class.

Costumes - Each child performing in our end of year show will be responsible to purchase a costume. If a child withdraws after November 10, 2023 the remaining balance for the costume must be Paid. The cost is as follows:

THE COST IS AS FOLLOWS:

- ➤ Child size costumes range \$75-\$95. A deposit of \$40 is due in November, balance is due in March.
- Adult size costumes range \$80-\$100. A deposit of \$50 is due in November, Balance is due in March.
- ➤ Company students and production performers' costumes range from \$90-\$120. Costumes will be paid in full in March.

Show Fee - A show fee will be applied to each account in January. This amount may be fundraised by selling a patron ad to a local business. Paying fee directly entitles you to place an ad on behalf of your child in our Show Journal.

► Show fee \$80 per student or \$120 per family with multiple students.

PLACEMENT POLICY – REGISTRATIONS WILL BE REVIEWED. EACH STUDENT'S REGISTRATION PLACEMENT WILL BE CONFIRMED BY EMAIL BEGINNING IN AUGUST. STUDENTS WILL BE PLACED IN CLASSES THAT ARE DEEMED AGE AND LEVEL APPROPRIATE BY OUR PROFESSIONAL INSTRUCTORS. DURING THE FALL STUDENTS WILL BE EVALUATED AND CLASS LEVELS MAY CHANGE AS A RESULT. WE RECOGNIZE THE BALANCE BETWEEN SKILL AND AGE AND WE WILL MAKE EVERY EFFORT TO PLACE STUDENTS IN A CHALLENGING CLASS WHERE THE STUDENTS FEEL ENCOURAGED AND NOT OVERWHELMED.

CLASS LEVELS – CLASS LEVELS ARE PUT IN PLACE SO THAT EACH STUDENT GETS THE VERY MOST OUT OF THEIR DANCE EDUCATION. EACH STUDENT PROGRESSES AT A DIFFERENT PACE. THE MORE FOCUSED A STUDENT REMAINS ON THEIR OWN PERSONAL GROWTH THE FASTER THEY WILL GROW. TEACHER RECOMMENDATION/APPROVAL IS REQUIRED IN ALL LEVELS 1 TO ADVANCE.

PREREQUISITES - STUDENTS REGISTERING FOR JAZZ, MODERN, OR CONTEMPORARY MUST ALSO BE REGISTERED IN A BALLET CLASS.

GENERAL GUIDELINE FOR STUDENT PLACEMENT - NEW DANCE FAMILIES PLEASE REACH OUT TO THE STUDIO BEFORE REGISTERING. WE WILL HELP WITH CLASS LEVEL AND SELECTION.

Combo I – Age 3-4 Combo II – Age 4-5 Combo Ballet/Tap Hip Hop - 5 and 6 year olds with previous Combo experience Beginner – Age 5-6 Level I – Age 6-8, students should have 1-2 years experience in the genre.
